

SEVEN THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW BEFORE ORDERING COILS & SHEETS

Ordering coils and sheets requires attention to detail to ensure you get the right products. To help make that ordering process easier, we've put together a guide detailing some common considerations to contemplate before placing your order.



CHOOSE YOUR MATERIAL COLOR, THICKNESS, AND TYPE

Be sure to include the specifics of your material, such as your choice between steel and aluminum, gauge, and desired color, subject to availability. The more details you provide, the easier it will be to process your order.



SPECIFY THE COIL DIMENSIONS AND QUANTITY YOU REQUIRE

Choose from 20, 22, and 24-inch standard coil widths. Additional and custom coil widths are also available, but may incur dropcut fees. Please specify your units of measurement and delineate between square and linear footage. Each pair of coils must share the same linear footage.



KNOW YOUR ROLLFORMING MACHINE'S LIMITATIONS

If you're using an overhead reel rack, specify your maximum coil weight. This will vary based on length and material used.



DETERMINE THE RIGHT NUMBER OF SHEETS

While our standard sheets are 4x10 feet, we do offer custom sheet sizes up to 12 feet. Use our [Trim Calculator](#) to easily figure out how many flat sheets you need for your project.



MATCH YOUR ACCESSORIES TO YOUR PROFILE'S ENGINEERING

Check your engineering specifics and ensure that all the accessories you're planning on ordering are a match with your desired panel profile.



UNDERSTAND THE LEAD TIMES ASSOCIATED WITH YOUR ORDER

Communicate with your supplier to get an estimate of the time it will take to produce and ship your order so you can prepare accordingly.
